Admission to Year 12 Community & Voluntary Controlled Schools

For students who are currently in Year 11 at a school and wish to progress into Year 12 at The Nelson Thomlinson School. The following information is designed to help you understand how to apply for a place in Year 12 and, therefore, make your application easier.

- Ask the school for a copy of its Sixth Form prospectus.
- Check that the courses and the subjects you wish to study are provided by NTS.
- Attend the information evening on **Tuesday 10th January 2017**.
- Fill in the application and submit this to the school by **Monday 13th March 2017**.
- If you apply after 13th March 2017 you will only be considered for a place after all those who applied on time have been offered a place. This may mean that all the available places have been offered to other students.
- We will write to you on Wednesday 19th April to inform you whether you have been offered a conditional school place in Year 12. This offer of a place will be conditional to you meeting the minimum requirements for entry to the school Sixth Form AND the entry requirements for your courses.
- Year 12 Induction Day takes place on **Tuesday 27th June 2017**. All students who have been given a conditional offer of a place in the Sixth Form are asked to attend. If you are unable to attend, please let the school know so that information can be forwarded to you.
- **Confirmation of places**
On GCSE results day, **24th August 2017**, students from other schools should collect their GCSE results and bring them along to the Nelson Thomlinson School **between 1 pm and 2 pm**. They will be checked by the Head of Sixth Form or the Assistant Head of Sixth Form and a place confirmed. If a prospective student has not met the conditions for entry to the Sixth Form, alternative options can be discussed, including study at college or with local training agencies.
- Students who apply late will be made an offer dependent on the availability of places in the Sixth Form **and** places in their chosen subjects. Where places in their chosen subjects are not available, prospective students will be offered an alternative or given advice on the other options available to them.
