KS3

Format	Purpose
A4 green class book	Pupils in Years 7-9 complete notes, classroom exercises and activities and some homework in these books. These are checked and light touch marked by the teacher. Work may be self and peer assessed by the pupil.
A4 blue exercise book	Practice and draft work which directly feeds into unit assessments together with unit assessments pieces are completed in this book. Teacher feedback and pupil action on feedback takes place in these books.

KS4 (Year 10 and Year 11)

Format	Purpose
A4 green class book	Pupils in Year 10 and 11 complete notes, classroom exercises and activities and some homework in these books, linked to the GCSE Language examinations. These are checked and light touch marked by the teacher. Work may be self and peer assessed by the pupil.
A4 purple class book	Pupils in Year 10 and 11 complete notes, classroom exercises and activities and some homework in these books, linked to the GCSE Literature examinations. These are checked and light touch marked by the teacher. Work may be self and peer assessed by the pupil.
A4 blue assessment book	Practice and draft work which directly feeds into unit assessments together with unit assessments pieces are completed in this book. Unit assessment pieces mirror the tasks students will complete in the Literature and Language GCSE examinations. Teacher feedback and pupil action on feedback takes place in these books.

KS5

A4 folder, sub-divided into topics/ modules	Pupils in Years 12 and 13 complete notes, classroom exercises and activities and some homework in these books, linked to their AS and A2 examinations. Assessments are completed on file paper and stored in these folders by the student. Work may be self and peer assessed by the student; every 2-3 weeks, the teacher will mark in detail, a practice or draft contributing to an assessment. Assessments are marked in detail by the teacher, on a minimum, half termly basis.
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
