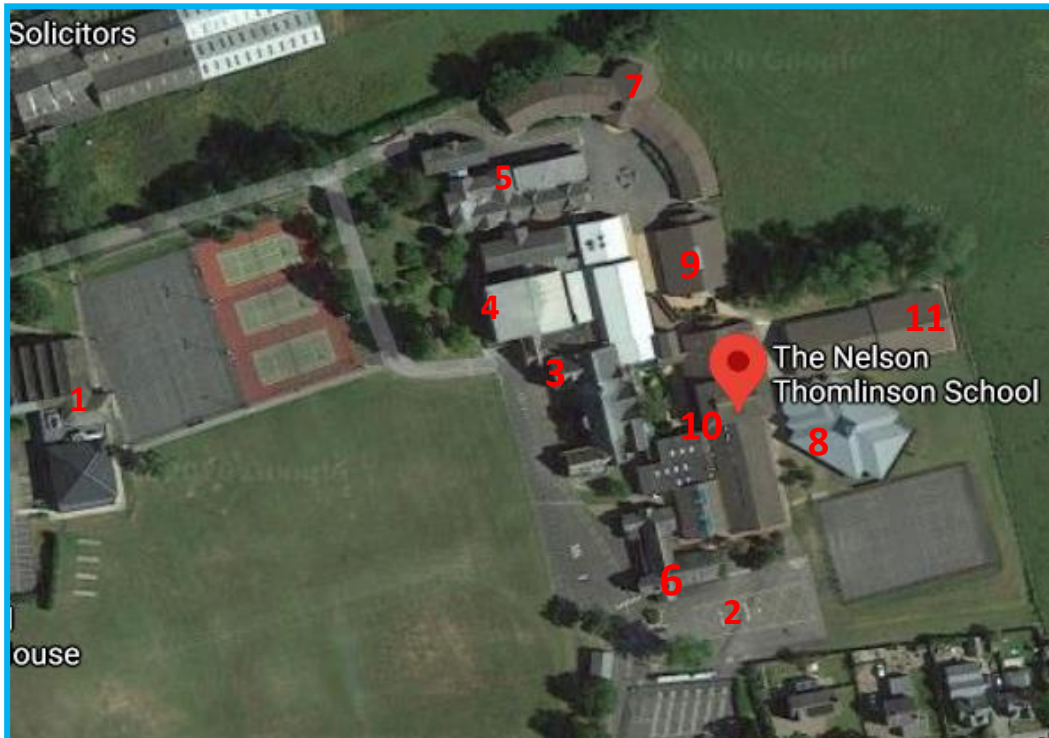


The Perfect Uniform
