Dear Parents and Carers,

I had written a two-page letter to go out to parents tomorrow to explain our plan for the first week of January. The government's announcement this evening, however, means that everything will need to be postponed a week. As things stand now, from the week commencing 4th January, Year 11 and 13 will receive remote teaching, and we will also supervise in school vulnerable children and Year 7 children of Key Workers, as we did for the last lockdown. We will then resume face-to-face teaching from 11th January for Year 11 and 13 (and, potentially, mass lateral flow testing for others, by appointment). All other year groups will return to school for face-to-face teaching on 18th January. There is likely to be more detail coming out shortly on all this; please, therefore, keep an eye on Parent Mail, Facebook and the school website in the next few days.
