Dream Placement is a unique Cumbrian initiative, project managed by the Centre for Leadership Performance (CfLP), that brings together bright, motivated young students aged 16-18 with some of the most forward-looking and successful businesses in the county.

Dream Placement is a leadership development programme that for some young people will result in a week's Dream Placement in industry. The Dream Placement scheme has been co-created by CfLP with businesses across Cumbria who want to connect with their future workforce and showcase the breadth of opportunities within their organisations. The scheme gives all young people who apply development opportunities and a chance to come together with employers for safe, meaningful dialogue and engagement at each stage of this 6-month programme.

Yearly, applications open between September and end of October; shortlisted applicants are invited to a selection event early December where they are interviewed by 2 host companies for a chance to secure their Dream Placement. Successful students then have a development event in January and placements take place in the February half-term week. A showcase event takes place in March. THINKING OF RETURNING TO YOUR ROLE AS A HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL? WE CAN HELP YOU!

THIS MESSAGE GOES OUT TO ALL PARENTS, CARERS AND MEMBERS OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY WHO MAY ONCE HAVE BEEN A HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL SUCH AS A NURSE OR MIDWIFE AND NOW CONSIDERING A RETURN. RETURNING HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS HAVE A KEY ROLE TO PLAY IN ENSURING PATIENTS AND SERVICE USERS HAVE ACCESS TO EXPERIENCED AND WELL-TRAINED CARE STAFF EQUIPPED WITH THE RIGHT SKILLS. HEALTH EDUCATION ENGLAND (NHS) PROVIDE FUNDING TO SUPPORT THE PATHWAYS TO RETURN AND ARE KEEN TO SUPPORT OR ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE IF YOU ARE CONSIDERING RETURNING TO PERHAPS NURSING, MIDWIFERY OR IF YOU TRAINED AS AN ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONAL (AHP) OR A HEALTHCARE SCIENTIST (HCS) BUT HAVE SINCE LEFT THE PROFESSION.
